




HISTORY DEPARTMENT

The Department of Computer Science was incepted in 1994. Surendranath College is the first college under Calcutta University which can get the credit to flag the honor of introducing this course. Hence the Department of Computer Science in Surendranath College bears a historical importance in this aspect. The teaching-learning process of the subject Computer Science in B.Sc. Pass level was begun in 1994 under the supervision of Prof. Birendra Narayan Roy, the then Head of the Department of Physics. He was the founder of the Department of Computer Science.
