MEMORANDUM

The undersigned is directed to say that the question of stoppage of subscription towards G. P. Fund a few months before the date of retirement of a Government employee on attaining the age of superannuation has been under consideration of the Government for sometime past, with a view to ensuring speedy finalisation of Provident Fund claims after retirement.

In terms of F. D. Memo. No. 2133-F, dt. 24.3.81 stoppage of compulsory subscription towards Provident Fund six months before the date of retirement of attaining the age of superannuation was made optional. After careful consideration of the matter the Governor has now been pleased to decide that modification of F.D. Memo No. 2133-F, dt. 24.3.81 subscription towards G.P.F. shall be stopped compulsorily three months before the date of retirement (ii) D.D.O.'s shall commence processing the final payment cases three months preceding the date of retirement.
