



The analysis report of the survey carried out during this period is summarised below-




1. How much of the syllabus is generally covered in the classes in each semester? 385 responses




2. How well do the teachers prepare for the classes? 385 responses




### 3. How good are the teachers to communicate things in classes? 385 responses




### 4. The teacher's average approach to teaching can best be described as 385 responses



## 5. Fairness of the internal evaluation processes done by the teachers. $_{\rm 385\,responses}$


























